



**HANDI-STICK® CONSTRUCTION ADHESIVE** is a unique one-component polyurethane based foam adhesive which also is an effective hole filler and insulating sealant. One 24 oz. can of HANDI-STICK® replaces up to 10 quart tubes of traditional adhesive. Provides excellent adhesion for drywall, foamboard, FRP panels, plywood and most other building materials.

**DIRECTIONS:**

- ⇒ Wear impervious gloves, goggles and work clothes during use. Use with adequate ventilation.
- ⇒ Optimal temperature for use is between 65-100°F (18-38°C). Clean grease and oil off surfaces to be foamed. Cover surrounding surfaces.
- ⇒ Screw can onto gun coupling until it will go no further. Do not over tighten.
- ⇒ Grip can and gun with both hands and shake well.
- ⇒ Adjust bead with gun regulator screw. Squeeze trigger to dispense adhesive. Test on experimental surface. Dispense a 3/8" (9 mm) bead of adhesive.
- ⇒ For laminating on solid surfaces, apply around perimeter and use a zig-zag pattern in the middle for greater adhesion.
- ⇒ Set panel in place within 3 minutes. Do not "flash" the panel. Do not pull away the panel once in place. Secure with mechanical fasteners.
- ⇒ HANDI-STICK® CONSTRUCTION ADHESIVE will cure initially within 1 hour. Fully cures in 24 - 48 hours. Do not remove mechanical fasteners until product is fully cured. Adhesive strength is not achieved until product is cured.
- ⇒ For overnight storage, close gun regulator screw completely to secure trigger. Can must remain fastened to gun during storage. For longer storage consult gun instructions. Use HANDI-FOAM® POLYURETHANE CLEANER (P10083) to keep dispensing unit working smoothly. Store upright in a cool, dry area. Use remainder of can within 30 days.
- ⇒ Uncured foam may be removed with acetone. Cured foam must be removed mechanically.
- ⇒ Read all instructions and safety information prior to use of any product.
